AWARD AND QUALIFICATIONS

1. Studio awards are made during the first three weeks of every semester to qualified fine arts students. This form must be filled in and filed with the Fine Arts office by the deadline date posted for the semester. The number of awards depends upon the studio space available. Currently we have ten physical spaces for the studios.
2. Only certified majors in fine arts are qualified to apply (BA or BFA).
3. Awards are made on the basis of a portfolio review by the faculty, in a meeting called for that purpose. Your portfolio should consist of approximately 12 slides loaded properly in a carousel projector tray, with this form completed and attached.

OCCUPANCY AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Occupancy of the studio continues until the student graduates from the program or withdraws from the university. In the case of a semester's interruption in a student's program, the studio space will be awarded to another student, and the first available space will be restored to the returning student. This is to prevent precious space from turning into personal storage.
2. Occupants of the studios are expected to use the space for the production of their work. If a student does not use the space, or uses it as storage space, it will be re-assigned.
3. Occupants of the studios may be asked to share some duties that benefit the undergrad program in general, such as managing exhibitions for Gallery III, and attending occasional meetings in the studio area.
4. Except for the above stated rules, and the general rules of the university, governance of the studios will be the responsibility of the occupants. The current undergraduate program coordinator is the faculty member to which all questions should be directed.
