(All citations in the bibliography should be alphabetized by the author's last name. If the author's name is unknown, alphabetize by the first word of the title.)

How to Write an MLA Style Bibliography

(All of the sample citations given are from the MLA Style Manual. If you do not see an example that matches the resource you are trying to cite, please ask for the Manual at the Circulation Desk.)

Works Cited

(This must be typed and centered, 1 inch from the top of the page.)

Web Pages

☞ Start the first line at the left margin.

Author's Last Name, First Name. Title of the Web Page. Day Month (*abbreviated) Year of Access <Complete URL>.

☞ Indent ½ inch before every line but the first.

Article in a magazine

Author's Last Name, First Name. "Article Title in Quotations." Magazine Name Day Month (*abbreviated) Year: Page Numbers.

Article in a journal

Author's Last Name, First Name. "Article Title in Quotations." Journal Name Volume Number (Year): Page Numbers.

Videocassette or DVD

Title. Dir. Director's Name. Media type (Videocassette, DVD). Distributor, Year.

Article in an Encyclopedia

Author's Last Name, First Name. "Article Title in Quotations." Encyclopedia Title. Year ed.

Book

Author's Last Name, First Name. Title. City of Publication: Publisher, Year of Publication.

Article in a newspaper

Author's Last Name, First Name. "Article Title in Quotations." Newspaper Name Day Month (*abbreviated) Year, Edition: Section Page Numbers.
